## CAFOD

**\*CAFOD: Fix the Food System campaign update:** - Aiysha in Bangladesh grows her own food. Previously she worked as a labourer earning BDT 5,000/month (about £30); barely enough to support her family. After joining a CAFOD-supported project, Aiysha became Assistant Secretary of the Carrot Farmers Field School and learned about Agroecology which is a sustainable way of growing food that works with nature. By using agroecology, farmers use their local knowledge to save seeds and grow food that fits their specific climate, soil and culture. Her income has risen to BDT 9,500/month (around £57). We are asking the UK Government to support these farmers by re-focusing some funding from its aid budget to locally led agroecology projects. By doing this, the UK could play a key role in supporting ways of producing food that are more resilient to the changing weather patterns. Please send a message to the Minister of International Development, Baroness Chapman, to ensure that the UK supports climate-resilient ways of growing food.
