**\*CAFOD: Call on the Prime Minister to Tackle the Global Debt Crisis:** Next year the UK will chair the G20. This is a critical moment and a test of leadership. We are calling on the UK government to act now and take immediate action: *Pass the UK Debt Justice Law*. Require wealthy banks based in London to participate in debt relief, so they can no longer profit from countries struggling with unsustainable debts. *Lead urgent global reform*. Use the UK's G20 presidency to bring governments together to fix the broken global debt system and guarantee fast, fair and effective debt relief for countries in crisis. At the end of Mass today at St. Joseph's, we are collecting signatures for a CAFOD petition about this global debt crisis which is causing terrible suffering all around the world. Please stop for a minute as you leave and lend your support. Thank you for helping to build a better world.
